A Tour de Lane First – *Clear to the Coast*, a century ride

EUGENE, Ore. (May 1, 2015) –*Clear to the Coast* marks Tour de Lane’s first bicycle riding adventure to the Oregon coast. This one-way century offers a ride over the coast range on beautiful, nearly car-free BLM roads. Riders will enjoy a beer on the beach in Winchester Bay and get a shuttle back in time for Saturday night's catered dinner. Alan Bennett cycling columnist and co-author of [Mountain Bike! Southwest Washington](#) chose the route for its beauty. All of Lane County’s geographic drama is on display in this ride, farmland, mountains and ocean. Saturday’s one-day ride *Clear to Coast* may be registered for separately from the weekend of available rides.
